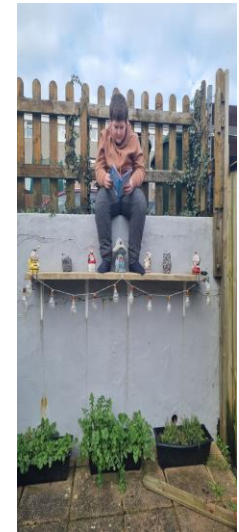

Our wonderful team went to town on their World Book Day costumes!



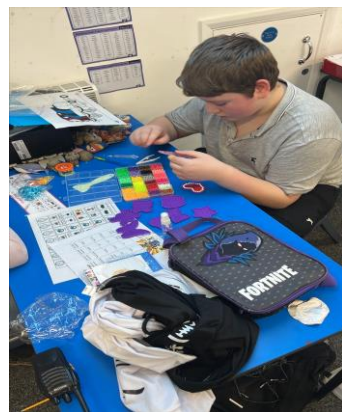
One of Callum's favourite learning activities involves learning his maths and English from the boards in the classroom as he says he can learn whilst standing up!



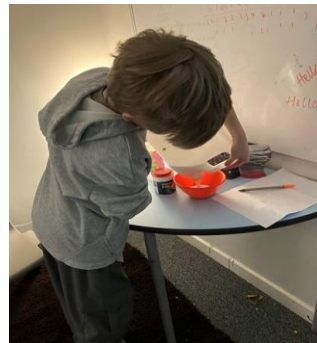
Caramel making became scientific for Charlie this week as he had to decide on the perfect temperature and colour.



The pupils are really enjoying following their new fitness programme and attend the gym locally!



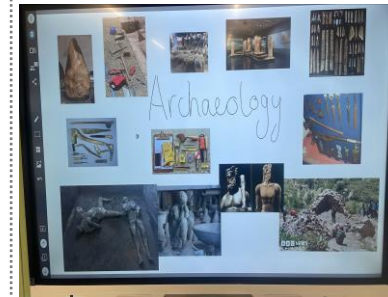
Kyle's attention to detail was exceptional this week when working on his fine motor skills.

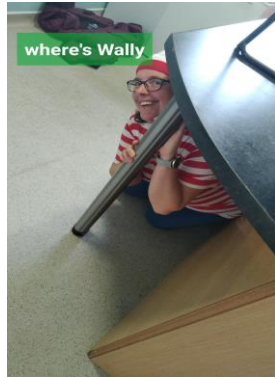

Can you spot Wally in our pictures?

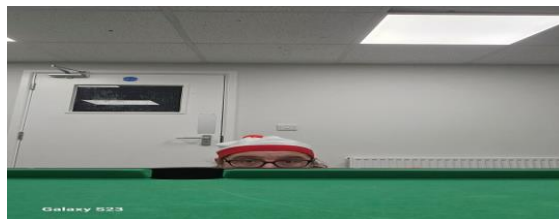


Thank you to our teams!
