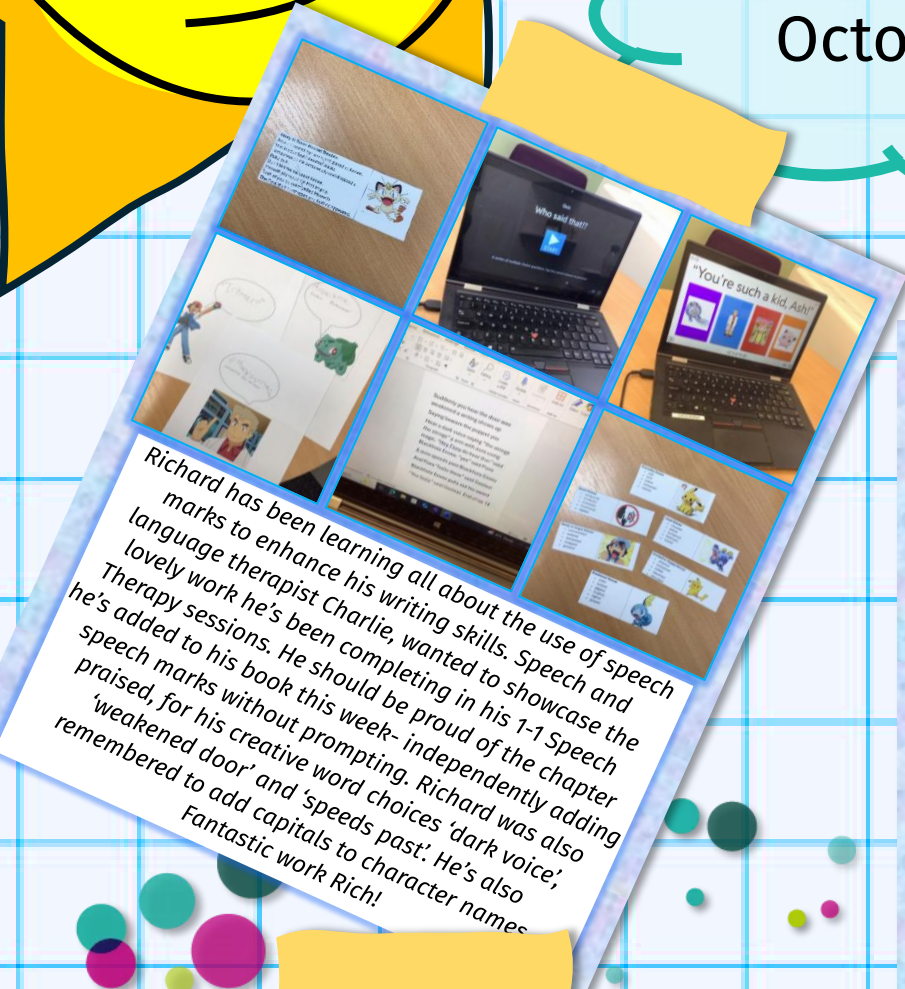
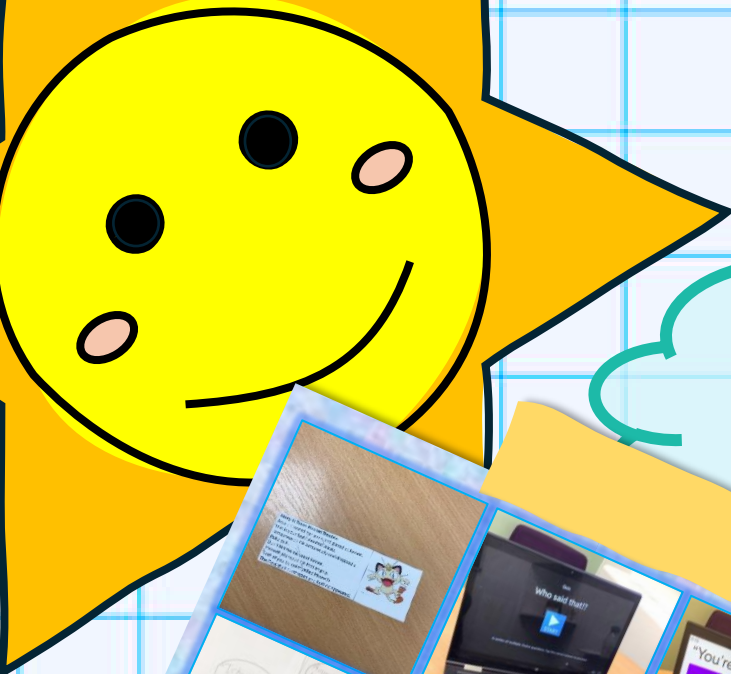


Newsletter October 2025

Creative Corner



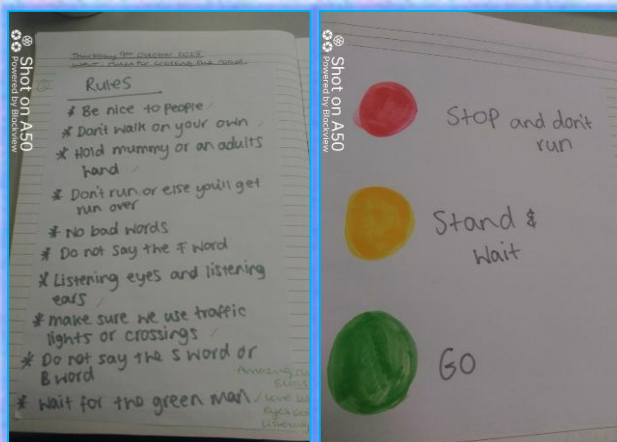

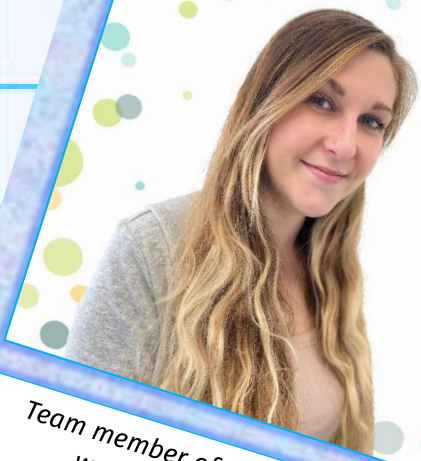

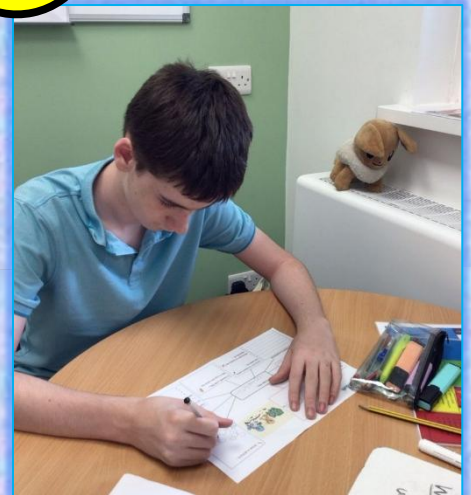
