

Key Stage 2

Our KS2 students are taught in mixed age classes and the curriculum is based on a thematic approach that is largely topic based. As with all of our students, their EHCP outcomes and Pathway Plans inform our educational delivery in a cross curricular approach. Students in KS2 are offered discrete interventions to support learning in numeracy and literacy, where teaching occurs in small group or 1:1 scenarios.

Lessons are planned in half termly blocks, aiming to meet the needs of each student, whilst monitoring progress and coverage through BSquared, and these are mapped against EHCP outcomes. The use of our tracking and monitoring software allows us to evidence progress and ensure that curriculum coverage is responsive and appropriate to the agreed needs/targets.

KS2 Students have access to AQA Unit Awards and the ASDAN Key Steps programme, aimed at the level at which they are working.

Where it is appropriate to extend the curriculum offer for specific students, the School is able to offer access to the Cornerstones entire KS2 curriculum. This approach enables teachers to deliver subject areas through a range of projects that are appropriately matched to the specific abilities and interests of students and are accompanied by a wide range of appropriate resources that stretch students and build upon prior knowledge.
