

Key Stage 4

In Years 10 and 11, students continue to have access to a broad and balanced curriculum with a key focus on English and Maths, and PSHE (Including careers, finances, and work experience). Their curriculum offer remains highly personalised but is focused upon a successful transition to their post 16 opportunities in education or work-based training. Students are supported in the preparation for, and completion of Work Experience and encouraged and supported to explore additional local education and training providers in order to make informed decisions regarding their options following leaving school.

Student's personalised timetables can be reviewed and altered as their interests and needs dictate. During KS4 students are encouraged to undertake formal academic and vocational qualifications as appropriate, however these are not viewed as the only markers of success. Accepting that the emphasis is placed upon EHCP outcomes throughout as student's time at the school; ultimately our goal is to prepare all students with the skills and attributes to enable them to have the best opportunity to live a happy and fulfilling lives and to continue as active citizens.
